- 1) Passport provides individuals in need of nursing home level of care with an in-home alternative.
- 2) Eligibility requirements include 1. over 60 years of age; 2. Medicaid-eligible--Passport is a Medicaid waiver program; 3. Meets nursing home level of care; 4. Have a physician's approval; 5. Health needs can be met safely in the home
- 3) Services individuals receive may include: Personal Care Assistance, Homemaker, Transportation, Emergency Response System, Home Delivered Meals, Adult Day Services, Chore, Minor Home Modification, Social Work Counseling

In home assessment for the program is free.

During in-home assessment, a care plan of services is developed.

Individuals must maintain Medicaid eligibility to continue to be enrolled on Passport waiver.
