Information about the program:

- 1. Assessors complete Long Term Care Consultation for individuals of all ages to discuss care options and referrals to meet their needs.
- 2. There is no charge for an in-home assessment to discuss your needs and options.
- 3. Assessor completes Assessments for Passport/Assisted Living Waivers and Non-Medicaid Care Coordination Program.
- 4. There is no charge for PASSPORT services if you are under a set income level. If you are over the income level, you may choose to pay a monthly amount determined at the time of enrollment or decline enrollment.
- 5. For Assisted Living Waiver the individual is responsible for paying a "room & board" rate and a possible patient liability amount depending on the individual's income.
- 6. Assessors complete desk reviews for individuals seeking nursing facility placement and have Medicaid payment.

Eligibility Criteria:

- The primary criteria for enrollment are age, level of care, and income.
- Individuals age 60 years and older for Passport and 21 years and older for Assisted Living and agreeable to participate.
- Have a physician's approval
- Meet financial requirements for assets/income
- Meet nursing home level of care (assistance w/activities of daily living)-All programs.
- Health needs can be met safely in the home
- Reside in a non-institutional settina
- Needs are not being met by current community services

Enrollment Process:

- 1. Assessor and program support specialist track status of case for eligibility criteria to be met.
- 2. Assessor orders Initial setup of services and enrolls the individual on to the PASSPORT or Assisted Living Program. Case Manager takes over and provides ongoing support after enrollment.
- 3. For AAA3 Non-Medicaid programs, Assessor will place individual on the waiting list and Non-Medicaid Case Managers monitor and enroll.
