

## **SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT**

**For PSA 3 Agency on Aging Inc.**

This is a summary of the annual report for PSA 3 Agency on Aging 3 Inc., EIN 34-1160526, Plan No. 001, for period 01//01/2013 through 12/31/2013. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

### **Basic Financial Statement**

Benefits under the plan are provided through a Group or individual Annuity Contract issued between PSA3 Agency on Aging Inc. and Mutual of America Life Insurance Company, ING, Thrivent for Lutherans. Plan expenses were \$65,114. These expenses included \$64,934 in administrative expenses, \$180 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, certain deemed distributions of participants loans of \$0, \$0 in forfeitures, \$0 in forfeitures incurred, \$0 in transfers, \$0 in financial adjustments.

A total of 63 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$1,740,043 as of 12/31/2013 compared to \$1,435,271 as of 01/01/2013. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$304,772. This includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$232,638 including employer contributions of \$54,250, employee contributions of \$55,480, rollover contributions \$0, forfeitures applied of \$0, designated Roth Contribution of \$0 designated Roth rollover contribution of \$0 loan principal repayments of \$0, loan interest payments of \$0, loan charge payment of \$0, expense charge reversal of \$0 forfeiture reversal of \$0 transfers earnings from investments.

The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

Lima, Ohio 45801 and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
